SOCIAL SECURITY (ASSURANCES OF SUPPORT) (FAHCSIA) DETERMINATION 2007

I am writing to the Office of Best Practice Regulation (OBPR) regarding the *Social Security (Assurances of Support) (FaHCSIA) Determination 2007*, which, as per the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*, had been scheduled to sunset on 1 April 2018. However, it has been decided that the instrument is to be remade without significant amendments.

The Department of Social Services certifies that the *Social Security (Assurances of Support) (FaHCSIA) Determination 2007* is operating effectively and efficiently, and that therefore a Regulation Impact Statement is not required for this regulation to be remade.

The assessment that the regulation is operating effectively and efficiently has been informed by a consultation process which involved the Department of Human Services and the Department of Home Affairs, over the period from February 2017 to February 2018.
